

BETTY YUEN Chairman of CLP Power Hong Kong


In an exclusive interview with Betty Yuen, Chairman of CLP Power Hong Kong, Chairman of the Hong Kong General Chamber of Commerce (HKGCC) and founding member of JCI Queensway, we delve into her experiences and gain valuable insights into personal and professional development. Betty shares anecdotes from her time in JCI, highlights the skills she acquired, and offers advice to young individuals aspiring to succeed in Hong Kong and China's dynamic landscape.

HER TIMES IN JCI QUEENSWAY AND IMPACT ON HER FUTURE DEVELOPMENT



Betty reflects on her time as a founding member of JCI Queensway, active from 1984 to 1988. She recalls the camaraderie and sense of belonging she experienced within the chapter. While she initially joined to expand her network and to "work on projects with peers of similar age", she discovered that JCI offered much more than that. Betty acknowledges that her JCI experience went beyond just having fun. She learned crucial skills that shaped her future career.

Betty cherishes the memories of her role as local Vice President and Deputy National Conference Director working with PNP Senator Larry Lau, which provided her with valuable leadership skills. Although she admits to not being a social person, her involvement in JCI allowed her to develop essential communication and teamwork abilities. "One thing I learnt is how to motivate and manage your Organisation Committee members as a leader with no formal authority, because everyone is a volunteer." Additionally, through collaboration and sponsorship activities, she learned the art of persuasion. Beside basic technical skills, as she progressed from lower-level positions to managerial roles, she acquired more importantly the ability to negotiate and influence others effectively. "Putting into the context of my career, it is 20% technical + 80% negotiation skill even for projects as large as infrastructures. These are skills that cannot be mastered by






reading a book but only through practice."

Betty emphasises the importance of project organisation skills, including the allocation of manpower and responsibilities. JCl provided her with a platform to master these skills, which proved to be transferable to various professional endeavours. She also credits JCl for helping her develop public speaking skills. Overcoming her initial timidity, she participated in the JCl Public Speaking Championship, facing her fears and emerging with increased confidence.

CHINA'S EMERGENCE IN THE INTERNATIONAL ARENA AND HOW YOUNGER GENERATION PREPARE FOR THE OPPORTUNITIES

With past experience in CLP Hong Kong working on business strategies in mainland China, as well as actively bridging HK business with the Mainland as Chairman of HKGCC, Betty's insights on Sino-Hong Kong relations are invaluable. She acknowledges the complexities of geopolitics and the challenges posed by protectionism. However, she asserts that China still presents numerous opportunities. "The history of modern China is nothing short of challenges, but we have stood the test of time, survived and thrived." She highlights the increasing integration between mainland China and Hong







Kong, driven by policies such as the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area (GBA) and the Belt and Road (B&R) Initiative. These initiatives have opened doors for business, connection, and personal development opportunities for young people.

Betty advises young individuals to maintain a positive attitude and embrace a mindset focused on grasping opportunities. She encourages them to expand their networks, learn about different businesses, understand how society functions, and gain knowledge about the global landscape. "By understanding the success factors and challenges in different markets, you can identify your niche and position yourself for success."



She acknowledges the dominance of social media and rise of "slashers" – individuals balancing multiple side businesses or hobbies – and the pursuit of work-life balance among young people. However, she cautions against neglecting

one's primary career. Betty shares that employers may have concerns about new recruits who divide their attention between their primary job and side ventures. She advises young individuals to define their career paths clearly and prioritise their goals. She encourages them to invest their time wisely, focusing on activities that contribute to their professional growth and character building. "We in CLP encourage our staff to join the HK Auxiliary Police. It is not only a way of serving the society, I believe the training and scope of work also helps with your character building, communication skills and physical strength. In fact, we allow our staff members to attend the Auxiliary Police annual mandatory training without taking annual leave".

On the increasing competition for opportunities with Mainland talents, Betty pointed out three things Mainland jobseekers possess that are giving them a competitive edge. "It is fair competition: employers will hire the best and we are seeing many outstanding Mainland youths in recent years. They are strong in language, very industrious and hungry for knowledge." To stay competitive, she highlights the significance of continuous learning, staying informed about industry trends, proactively seeking opportunities and staying humble.

EXTRAORDINARY BRANDING AWARDS

"PROFESSIONAL, INNO-TECH & DUAL CIRCULATION"



The Extraordinary Branding Awards (EBA), first held in 2021, honors Hong Kong companies for maintaining brand excellence despite the pandemic's impact. Over the last three years, more than 65 local businesses, including Bonjour and eBanner, have been recognized. The 2024 EBA theme is "Professional, Inno-Tech & Dual Cirulation", focusing on Hong Kong's unique characteristics and JCI values. The award highlights professional services, innovation, and market expansion both domestically and overseas. It also emphasizes business matching in Hong Kong, the Greater Bay Area, Asia, and internationally. Winners get opportunities for direct exchanges in Nansha, Shenzhen, and Qianhai and invitations to JCI conferences, connecting them with a global network of 5,000 entrepreneurs more than 100 countries.

CARE FOR "LEFT-BEHIND ELDERLY"



Due to increased emigration, in recent years many Hong Kong elderly are left alone, affecting their mental health. 
