## EBA 2022

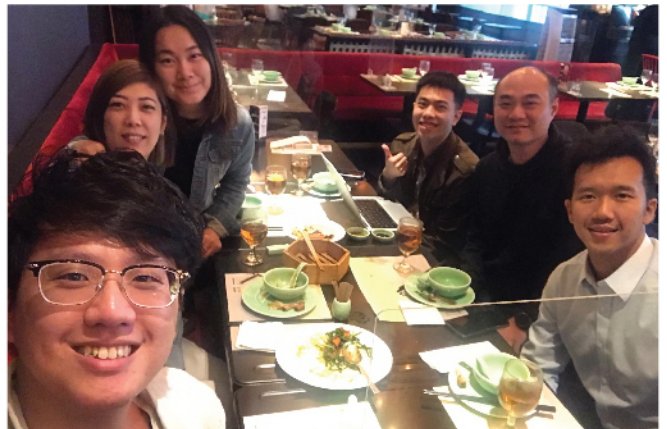

# Leadership Development

The Chinese authoritative classics of Confucianism “Great Learning” of “Book of Rites” (禮記·大學) emphasizes the importance of Self-cultivation (修身), which is the prerequisite of collaboration and leadership. We plan to hold a series of seminars to discuss “Introspection” (內省), which may consist of topics such as self-cognition, unlocking potential skills, personal branding, and cognitive behavioral therapy. Participants could recognize the characteristics and value of themselves, and hence to resolve improvements and cooperate with each other, so as to work out team spirit.

One of the key points of membership retention is to ensure members’ understanding of their organization. This year, we will conduct workshops for new members to highlight JCI knowledge, structure and value etc.; especially to introduce more about culture and history JCI Queensway.
